February is Heart Health Month

It all starts with managing your cholesterol. High LDL cholesterol (the bad type) can double your risk of heart disease.

Making a few lifestyle changes can lower your cholesterol and reduce your risk for heart disease:

• **Get some exercise.** It takes only 30 minutes of moderate intensity exercise each day to make a difference.

• Slim down. A 10-pound weight loss can lower blood pressure and reduce strain on your heart.

• **Eat a balanced diet.** A diet of lean meat, fish, low-fat dairy, whole grains, fruits and vegetables can help reduce plaque that clogs arteries and blood vessels.

- Cut back on sugar, salt and drinking.
- Quit smoking. Smoking can damage your heart and blood vessels.
- Manage your stress. Chronic stress can raise bad cholesterol and lower good cholesterol.
