



THE MAYFLOWER ESL PROJECT

Due to religious persecution, 64 Chinese Christians, known as Mayflower Church, were forced into exile since 2019. In collaboration with the US government, numerous organizations, and dedicated supporters, ChinaAid, a Christian human rights organization in Midland, Texas, helped rescue, advocated for and resettled Mayflower Church in safe places. In December 2023, all 64 members moved to Midland and Odessa to make their permanent home. To empower them during their resettlement process, ChinaAid plans to offer intensive English classes for the 30 adult members this summer (April & May). Local volunteers are crucial in supporting these asylum seekers.
